Memberships

Membership Grades and Qualification.

Membership in the Society is open to all people with Nepalese background/connection and friends of Nepal who have degree in an engineering field or in a closely related /scientific/technical area that support and enhance the profession of engineering through education, practice, research, and service. The voting membership grades of the Society are Member, Senior Member, and Fellow. The non-voting membership grade of the Society is Student Member.

Student Member:

To be eligible for the grade of Student Member, an individual shall be enrolled at least half-time in a 4-year undergraduate program or at least half-time in a graduate program in any branch of engineering.

Member:

To be eligible for the grade of Member, an individual shall:

Criterion 1: have been graduated with a bachelor's degree in engineering or closely related scientific/technical field; OR.

Criterion 2: have been graduated with a graduate degree in engineering or closely related scientific/technical field; OR.

Criterion 3. have been graduated with an associate degree in engineering AND has 3 years of professional experience in engineering.
