The Society's Goals for Next Two Years (2016-2018)

We would like to extend our sincere appreciation for electing us to serve you in a position of Board of Directors and Officers of American Society of Nepalese Engineers (ASNEng) for 2016-2018 term. We will abide by the Society's ByLaws and bring forth programs that promote engineering, scientific, and technological advancement in Nepalese community in Nepal and in the United States. We will work to create better environment for all the members of the Society to actively participate in various activities to fulfill the following goals for our 2016-2018 term:

1. **Website and Logo (Priority 1):** The Society's website will be modified to include features that are more user-friendly when it comes to membership application, upgrade, membership renewal, and email management. We will modify the look of the website using dynamic features. We will also rethink about modifying the Society's logo.
2. **Meetings and Document Management (Priority 1):** Meeting minutes and financial documents must be readily available online and/or via email to all members. These document shall be distributed/posted timely, immediately after the meetings. Other important documents will be organized in a way that they will be available to the Board and the members when necessary. The meeting discussions sometimes have tangled in trivial and technical issues rather than discussion on policies and strategies. Use of technology could help the meeting attendees to review and discuss the agenda ahead of time and perform side discussion if needed. The team will prepare a Meeting Operating Procedure (MOP) for better meetings. The MOP will be presented in the first BOD meeting.
3. **Local Chapters and other Committees:** We will establish following committees to promote the Society's activities:
 - a) We will establish at least two more local chapters by 2018. **(Priority 2)**
 - b) We will establish Advisory Committees to accommodate the Society's important members. **(Priority 1)**
 - c) We will establish Student Committee to bring together the Nepalese Engineering/IT Students studying in different universities in the United States. **(Priority 1)**
4. **Funds:** The stability of the Society solely depends on the availability of the funds. We will create a team of experts to increase the Society's revenues. The Board of Directors will work closely to increase the funds \$25,000 by 2018 **(Priority 1)**.
5. **Scholarship Programs:** Research Grants in Nepal and Scholarships in the U.S. are essential expand our program area. We will establish following scholarships/grants in Nepal:
 - a) Establish at least one scholarship for engineering students in the U.S. **(Priority 1)**
 - b) Establish one Research Grant in Nepal. **(Priority 1)**
6. **Programs in Nepal:** We will initiate following programs in Nepal;
 - a) Organize International Conference in Nepal by 2018. **(Priority 1)**
 - b) Launch at least one program in Nepal – Educational/Rural area Drinking Water Program/Building Toilets in rural area. **(Priority 3)**

7. **Membership and Recruitment (Priority 2):** Members of the Society are the backbone for the Society's success. We will streamline the membership application and approval process. By 2018, we will increase Members/Life Members by 100. All the student members from 2008 thru 2013 will be contacted and they will be requested to upgrade their memberships to member grade.
8. **Membership Benefits:** The Society's members expect some benefits from the Society. We will provide following benefits to the Society's members.
 - a) Launch PDH hours for members via conferences and webinars. *(Priority 1)*
 - b) Discounted rates in the Annual Conferences. *(Priority 1)*
9. **Amend Bylaws (Bylaws Committees):** The bylaws will be amended to clarify:
 - a) Election Process, Responsibilities transfer of newly elected BOD and officers. *(Priority 2)*
 - b) Requirements for Society's Memberships *(Priority 2)*
10. **Committees/Subcommittees:** We will establish following subcommittees to enhance the Society's activities:
 - a) Establish Student Committee. *(Priority 1)*
 - b) Establish Advisory Committee. *(Priority 1)***
 - c) Void Inactive Committees for example Program Committee. *(Priority 2)*
11. **Newsletter (Newsletter Committees):** The newsletter committee will use the new technology similar to item#2 to modify the document online.
 - a) Give full shape to Newsletter Committee. *(Priority 1)*
 - b) Publish Newsletter at least 3 time every year. *(Priority 2)*
12. **Prestigious Awards:** Award of Excellence for ASNEng members who provide outstanding support to ASNEng activities. *(Priority 1)*
13. **Professional Census (Liaison Committees):** We will join our hands together with other community organizations to collect census of Nepalese living in USA – especially for Engineers and Computer Professionals. We will work towards building relationships with ASCE and other engineering, professional and social organizations in USA. Similarly, we will work towards establishing a common platform for engineers and computer professionals where ideas can be shared among the Nepalese professionals across the globe.

 - b. Establish relations with other U.S. nonprofits and government agencies. *(Priority 3)*
