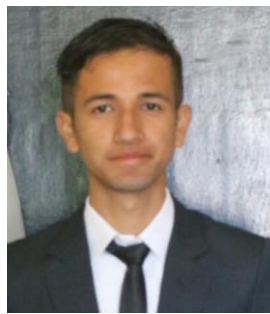
**Merit Awards for Students - Year 2016**
